

# Advice about radicalisation and extremism

**PREVENT aims to protect and promote the fundamental British values of democracy; rule of law; tolerance and individual liberty.**

**PREVENT** is not a political or ideological assault on communities, restricting freedom of speech, expressing opinions/views or impacting on your human rights, but first and foremost as a safeguarding issue. We need to make space for challenging conversations, however, need to protect each other from the influences of radicalisation, extremism and violence.

## V2R VULNERABILITY TO RADICALISATION

Vulnerability to Radicalisation or V2R occurs when a person, who as a result of their situation or circumstances, may be drawn or exploited into supporting terrorism or extremist ideologies associated with terrorist groups.

**PREVENT - To stop people becoming terrorists or supporting violent extremism.**

### Spot the Signs

Reading material relating to firearms; weapons; warfare tactics.

Nazi memorabilia; siege masks; combat/tactical clothing; specific tattoos; posters; drawings.

**CHANGE IN BEHAVIOUR** - Isolated; marginalised; trauma, ID confusion; rejected by family or faith & social groups; change in religious or political views; new networks of associates with extreme views.



### Share your Concerns

**REPORT IT!  
Don't ignore it!**

Complete a PREVENT referral - This enables professionals to help at an early stage and offer support.

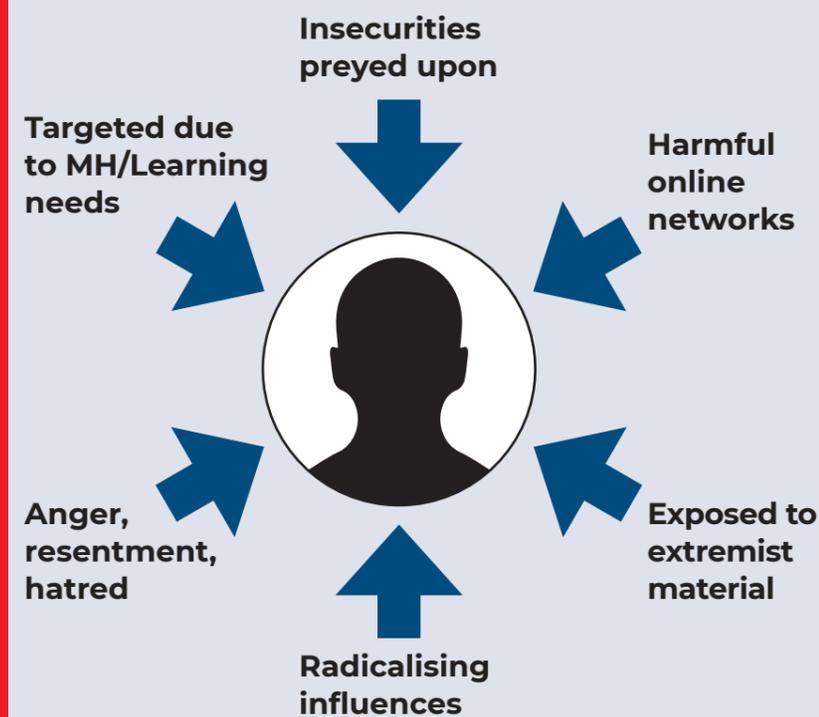
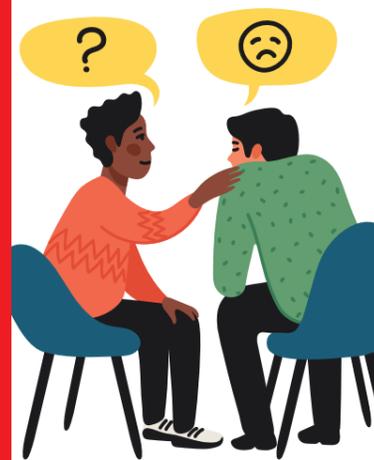

**ACT** | ACTION COUNTERS TERRORISM

- P** **Person** – Do they need safeguarding?
- R** **Research** – What are they looking at on the Web, Books, Reading material, Extremist organisations
- E** **Evident** change in behaviour/Appearance
- V** **Vocal** – What are they saying? Are their words causing concern to you or others?
- E** **Engage** – Are they becoming isolated, refusing to engage with friends, colleagues, lecturers, or associating with other like-minded individuals who cause similar concerns?
- N** **Notice** – No different to other Safeguarding issues,  
**Check** – Speak to colleagues, welfare about your concerns and Share...
- T** **TELL US** – Refer to the PREVENT Team.
